On February 28, 2022, The Board of Trustees awarded the New Cline Campus School Replacement Bid **to S & P/Satterfield & Pontikes Construction, Inc.** for the construction of the new facility. The new campus replacement will be built at 1550 West Boulevard, in the West Ranch subdivision of Friendswood ISD and will house grades K – 5<sup>th</sup> grade. Ground breaking took place on March 11, 2022. Substantial completion is projected for May of 2023. View the latest architectural renderings from the district's architect, PBK. ## Past Traditions...



Mr. Cline, known to his friends as "Connie", was a loving and caring person. He loved to play all sports, especially basketball. Mr.Cline was the first chemistry teacher at Friendswood High School. He held class at night after he got off work as a chemical engineer. He was on the Friendswood school board for 20 years. Ten years of that time he was the president of the school board. He died of cancer on September 2, 1978.
